### IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL CONTRACTORS

As from January 1st next ECSSA and RECI will be under direct control of CER (Commission for Energy Regulation) and as a result all the members and staff of both organisations will be subject to technical audit of all their work. This could mean that your work could be inspected separately by a C.E.R. official at any time.

We expect that an official of C.E.R. will visit our offices at regular intervals to inspect every detail of our organisation such as:

- Structure: day to day running etc,
- 2. Procedures for disciplinary action should it arise
- 3. Records of members attending training courses
- 4. Control of books of certificates
- 5. Control of Green copy of certificates returned from ESB
- 6. Detailed scrutiny of the quality as shown on these returned green copies
- 7. Any other investigation they may wish to do.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL CONTRACTORS continued**

#### **Quality of Certificates and Test Record Sheets**

This is referred to in point (6) above. However we must remind you that you have already been alerted to the very poor quality of the certs as experienced by our inspectors. (See the newsletters of March 2003 and December 2002.)

In order to protect the standing of the ECSSA within the Electrical Industry and in fairness to the many members whose Certs and Test Record sheets are excellent the Directors have confirmed the following disciplinary procedure to have effect on all Certs and Test Records issued after January 1st 2004.

#### Returned Certs to our office from ESB or copies of Certs seen by inspectors will be examined.

A properly completed Cert should have:

- 1. Clear legible writing
- 2. No blank spaces
- 3. Values for insulation resistance and resistance of protective conductors should be <u>within the limits laid</u> down in ETCI regulations and clearly shown in the appropriate boxes provided <u>(genuine Measured Readings Not Fictitious).</u>
- 4. M.P.R.A. number
- 5. Signed by contractor at pre-connection test only, before being sent to ESB
- 6. Signed at **post connection** test when appropriate, and yellow copy given to customer.

If in any calendar month a certificate of yours is found to be unsatisfactory for any of the points mentioned above you will automatically be subject to a fine of  $\leq 50$ , and no other services will be provided to you from our office until that fine is paid.

Note: In theory this could become €50 every month for 12 months but in practice we do not want to impose one single fine. It is completely up to you to ensure your certificates are completed correctly.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM ESB

In the near future ESB Networks will be sending important customer information leaflets via the Suppliers billing systems. The object of the exercise is to highlight areas of protection for electrical installations that are not mandatory in the current ETCI National Rules but are recognised as a risk to electrical equipment etc.

The areas concerned are protection for abnormal fluctuations in system voltage e.g. lightning and switching surge protection, under-voltage, loss of phase in a three-phase system etc...

In the leaflet we advise customers to contact an Electrical Contractor who is a member of a Regulatory body who will advise them on protection. It is important for electrical contractors to be aware of the type of equipment available to control these situations and to acquire some fundamental knowledge on the topic.

For information purposes we have included a copy of the notice that is being sent to all the customers shortly.
